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**Colorado Secretary of State

Election Complaints**

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Election Complaints

Complaints generally fall into one of three categories:

- 1) The Elector is unhappy but does not allege a violation of state law.
 - a. Complaints that fall within this category usually consist of an elector utilizing the complaint form to discuss an aspect of an election that they disagree with or feel should be handled differently.
 - i. Example: An elector disagrees with the federal requirement that states provide electors with the option to cast a provisional ballot. The Elector alleges a violation of a state law that does not fall under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of State's Office. In Colorado, the Secretary of State's Office is tasked with interpreting and administering the provisions of the Uniform Election Code (Title 1, C.R.S.). Election Complaints that do not allege a violation of the Uniform Election Code will not be investigated by this office.
 - a. Complaints that fall within this category usually tend to be related to a Municipal or Special District Election.
 - i. Example: an elector alleges that the designated election official for a special district did not properly summarize all submitted comments for the pro/con statement contained within the TABOR notice.
 - 3) The Elector alleges a violation of the Uniform Election Code (Title 1, C.R.S.) or the Election Rules (8 CCR 1505-1).
 - a. Complaints that fall within this category contain legitimate allegations that a designated election official violated a duty under Title 1 or violated a specific Election Rule.
 - i. Example: A custody log was not maintained for the transportation of voted ballots between a polling location and the County Clerk and Recorder's Office.
- 2) The Elector alleges a violation of state law that does not fall under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of State's Office. In Colorado, the Secretary of State's Office is tasked with interpreting and administering the provisions of the Uniform Election Code (Title 1, C.R.S.). Election Complaints that do not allege a violation of the Uniform Election Code will not be investigated by this office.
 - a. Complaints that allege violations of state law that can be refuted with documentation or affirmations from Clerk and Recorder can be handled in this manner.
 - i. Example: An elector alleges a violation of a state law that does not fall under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of State's Office. In Colorado, the Secretary of State's Office is tasked with interpreting and administering the provisions of the Uniform Election Code (Title 1, C.R.S.). Election Complaints that do not allege a violation of the Uniform Election Code will not be investigated by this office.
- 1) A letter will be sent to the County Clerk and Recorder requesting documentation to account for the deficiencies alleged in the Election Complaint.
 - a. Complaints that allege violations of state law that can be refuted with documentation or affirmations from Clerk and Recorder can be handled in this manner.
 - i. Example: An elector alleges a violation of a state law that does not fall under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of State's Office. In Colorado, the Secretary of State's Office is tasked with interpreting and administering the provisions of the Uniform Election Code (Title 1, C.R.S.). Election Complaints that do not allege a violation of the Uniform Election Code will not be investigated by this office.
- 2) A representative from the State Elections Division will visit the office of the County Clerk and Recorder for the purposes of investigating the complaint.

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If the allegations contained within the Election Complaint fall within the jurisdiction of the Secretary of State, the State Elections Division will issue a report at the conclusion of the investigation. Any report issued should contain the following:

- The allegations made in the Election Complaint;
- Any background information or facts gathered as a result of the investigation that are pertinent to the allegations in the Election Complaint;
- A resolution stating any future changes that the County will implement to remedy legitimate violations of the Election Code or Election Rules.

- a. The State Elections Division will visit a County Clerk and Recorder's Office to inspect voting equipment, or to respond to an allegation in a complaint that cannot be handled through a request for documentation. If the County Clerk and Recorder does not meet a request for documentation within a reasonable time period the State Elections Division may visit the County Clerk and Recorder's Office for the purposes of investigating the complaint.
- b. The State Elections Division will visit the County Clerk and Recorder's Office if the County Clerk and Recorder invites the State Elections Division to visit for reasons pertaining to the Election Complaint.
 - i. Example: A County Clerk and Recorder holds a public meeting to address the Complaint and invites the State Elections Division to attend.
- c. The State Elections Division will visit the County Clerk and Recorder's Office if the County Clerk and Recorder invites the State Elections Division to visit for reasons pertaining to the Election Complaint.

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
