- 10-09 CAMBER Clerk is interfering with Watchers
- 10-09 CLERK No room for watchers
- 10-09 CAMBER Watchers must have access

Protest - Violation of 10.12.5 - Defective envelopes shall be securely filed

- 10-22 CAMBER Objection to Clerk's plan to call electors for rejected ballots

Protest - Violation of 10.13 - Verification of replacement ballots

- 10-23 CAMBER Objection to Clerk's plan to open ballots early
- 10-26 CAMBER Reminder - Objection to Clerk's plan to open ballots early

Protest - Violation of 1-7.5-107 4(a) and (b) - Voter is required to provide postage

- 10-25 CAMBER If an elector returns a ballot by mail, the elector must provide postage

Protest - Objection to Computer Software and Procedures

- 10-26 CAMBER Objection to Computer Software and Procedures

Protest - Watchers denied access to poll book -- list of eligible voters

- 10-30 CAMBER Objection to Clerk's having no poll book or list of electors

Protest - Mismatched ballot and return-verification envelope

- 11-03 CAMBER Objection to Clerk swapping ballots and return-delivery envelopes
- 11-05 CLERK Response - you are mistaken
- 11-05 CAMBER Reminder - please explain more fully

Protest - Canvass Board accepts erroneous counts, vendor declares voter information to be proprietary

- 11-8 CAMBER Objection to Canvass Board decision and Vendor claim of proprietary election files
